COURSES

URBN 3710 Fundamentals of Urban Design *(Newly created undergraduate planning course)
This course provides a physical design component and is part of the urban design sequence available to undergraduate students in the Bachelor of Science in Urban Studies and Planning curriculum. It dissects the design process into simple and understandable components. The course content is valuable to anyone working in the field of planning

and the built environment. It will also aide in plan design review.

MURP 4710 Urbanism and Urban Design

The purpose of this course is to introduce students to fundamental concepts in urban design and the design process, and familiarize students with the roles the planner/public policy professional typically plays in the design process. The emphasis is on presenting urban design concepts from the perspective of the planning/public policy professional, and on developing skills with which to understand and crucially evaluate development proposals and their impact on the built environment.

MURP 4711 Principles of Landscaping

This course will focus on major issues of present day landscape architecture. Landscape and site design, plant material identification and usage, and installation and maintenance practices will be discussed. Special topics include large tree relocation, landscaping as a profession (business), graphics and model building techniques, the workings of the design process, and designer/client relations.

MURP 6180 Advanced Urban Design City and Regional Problems

This is a design course on large scale city and regional design projects. Graphic, model building presentation techniques will be stressed as well as designer/client relationships in a laboratory environment.
